February 19, 2010 – start time 8:30am

Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Registrations will not be processed before this date. Walk-in, faxed (**fax #: 503-760-3332**), and mailed registrations will be date/time stamped in order of receipt. Registrations which are received before the registration start date will be processed at the end of the day on February 19, 2010.

### **Registration Deadline: March 12, 2010**

Any registrations received after this date will incur a \$75 late fee. Equipment kit orders are due by this date, and cannot be canceled after this date.

### **Spring Term: April 5 – June 25, 2010**
